

World Premiere Film Showing:

The Pan People

written and directed by Peter Keelan

West Australian film maker and musician Peter Keelan travelled the world for a year collaborating with some of the world's greatest musicians, whilst living in Romania, Malawi, Bolivia and the Solomon Islands.

He encountered knife attacks, child prostitution, riots, malaria, thieves (who robbed him of everything in Prague en route to Romania), whilst filming the Pan People. From the world's greatest pan pipe virtuosi, subsistence farmers in drought stricken Africa, gypsy musicians from Romania and Quechuan Indians from Bolivia, his travels were turbulent and full of questions.

Most recently in the Solomon Islands he filmed and recorded traditional dancers and musicians living in the remote outer island of Malaita Is., living amidst a virgin rainforest in a small village at the tip of a mangrove swamp.

At Kulcha, Peter will be there to play some live music, together with guitarist Barry Heydenrych, and then introduce the film (1hr 30mins).
